Replique. Trade name for man-made yttrium aluminum garnet (YAG). resistivity. The electrical resistance offered to the passage of an electrical current. Usually expressed in ohm meters. Type I and Ila stones are generally classed as good insulators, i.e., good resistors to electricity. In contrast, Type Iib stones are semi-conductors of electricity.
