The official name of the vast collection of diamonds and jewelry comprising the Russian Regalia and the Romanoff jewels which is housed in the Kremlin, Moscow. Also known as the Russian Treasury of Diamonds and Precious Stones. The diamonds alone in this vast collection reportedly weigh more than 25,300 carats, about 1500 carats of which are represented by 70 important gems, such as the Orloff and the Shah.
